Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

Welcome to Debriefed ("the App"). Debriefed is a daily news quiz application that delivers curated questions based on global current affairs. This Privacy Policy explains how Debriefed handles information when you use the App.

We take your privacy seriously. In short: Debriefed does not require you to create an account, does not collect personally identifiable information, and does not track you as an individual.

2. Who We Are

3. Information We Do Not Collect

Debriefed is designed with privacy by default. We **DO NOT** collect:

- Your name, email address, phone number, or any contact information
- Account credentials — no registration or login is required to use the App
- Your location data or GPS coordinates
- Device identifiers such as IDFA, GAID, or IMEI
- Payment card details — subscription payments are processed entirely by RevenueCat and the App Store / Google Play; we never see or store your payment information

4. Information We Do Collect

Debriefed collects only the minimum data necessary to operate and improve the App:

4.1 Optional Display Name

When you first open the App, you may optionally enter a display name. This name is stored locally on your device only and is used solely to personalise your in-app experience (for

example, to greet you or display your name on the leaderboard within the App). We do not transmit, store, or process this name on any server. We do not validate or verify what you enter.

4.2 Anonymous Quiz Analytics

We collect anonymised data about quiz attempts, including which questions were answered, whether answers were correct, and which quizzes were completed. This data cannot be linked to any individual user as no account or persistent identifier is associated with it. We use this data solely to:

- Improve quiz content and question quality
- Understand aggregate usage patterns
- Identify and fix technical issues

4.3 Crash and Performance Data (Firebase Crashlytics)

We use Google Firebase Crashlytics to collect crash reports and performance diagnostics. This data includes device model, operating system version, app version, and a stack trace of the error. This information is anonymised and used exclusively to diagnose and fix technical problems with the App. Firebase Crashlytics may collect a Firebase Installation ID to deduplicate crash reports; this identifier is not linked to any personal information.

4.4 App Usage Analytics (Firebase Analytics)

We use Google Firebase Analytics to collect aggregated, anonymised data about how users interact with the App. This may include screens viewed, features used, and session duration. Firebase Analytics does not collect personally identifiable information. We have configured Firebase Analytics in compliance with privacy best practices, including disabling advertising ID collection.

5. Third-Party Services

Debriefed uses the following third-party services. Each operates under its own privacy policy:

5.1 Google Firebase (Crashlytics & Analytics)

Firebase is a platform provided by Google LLC. Firebase may process data on servers located in the United States and other countries. For more information, see Google's Privacy Policy at <https://policies.google.com/privacy> and Firebase's data processing terms.

5.2 RevenueCat

RevenueCat is used to manage in-app subscriptions (Debriefed Pro). When you purchase a subscription, RevenueCat processes transaction data including your App Store or Google Play purchase receipt. RevenueCat does not receive your payment card details. RevenueCat may store a pseudonymous user identifier to manage your subscription status. 5.3 Apple App Store / Google Play Store

Subscription purchases are processed by Apple or Google through their respective stores. Their privacy policies apply to those transactions. We receive only a confirmation of subscription status from RevenueCat — we do not receive your billing details.

6. How We Use Your Information

We use the limited data described above only to:

- Operate and deliver the App and its features
- Identify and fix bugs and crashes
- Understand how the App is used at an aggregate level to improve it
- Manage your Pro subscription status

We do not use your data for advertising, profiling, or any commercial purpose other than operating the App.

7. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We do not sell your data. We do not share your data with third parties except as follows:

- Service providers: Firebase and RevenueCat as described in Section 5, solely to provide their services to us
- Legal requirements: If required by law, court order, or regulatory authority, we may disclose data to the extent legally required
- Business transfers: If Debriefed is acquired or merged, data may be transferred as part of that transaction, subject to the same privacy protections

8. Data Retention

Because we do not collect personally identifiable information, there is no personal data to delete on our end. The optional display name you enter is stored only on your device and is removed when you uninstall the App or clear the App's local data.

Anonymised analytics data held by Firebase is retained in accordance with Firebase's default retention settings. Subscription records held by RevenueCat are retained as long as necessary to manage your subscription and comply with legal obligations.

9. Children's Privacy

Debriefed is a general-audience app and is not directed specifically at children under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children. Because the

App does not require account creation and collects no personal data, the risk of inadvertent collection is minimal.

If you are a parent or guardian and believe your child has provided personal information through the App, please contact us at support@getdebriefed.app and we will take appropriate action.

10. International Users and Data Transfers

Debriefed is available globally. If you access the App from outside the United States, please be aware that data processed by Firebase and RevenueCat may be transferred to and processed in the United States or other countries where their servers are located.

If you are located in the European Economic Area (EEA), United Kingdom, or Switzerland, you have certain rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) or equivalent legislation. Since we do not collect personally identifiable information, most of these rights have limited practical application. However, you may contact us at hello@getdebriefed.app with any privacy-related requests.

If you are located in Saudi Arabia, we process data in accordance with the Kingdom's Personal Data Protection Law (PDPL) to the extent applicable. As we do not collect personal data as defined under the PDPL, the law's substantive obligations are not triggered in most respects.

11. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect the data we handle. Our minimal data collection approach is itself a key privacy protection. Firebase and RevenueCat maintain their own security programmes in accordance with industry standards.

No method of transmission over the internet is 100% secure. However, given that we do not collect personally identifiable information, the risk to you as an individual user is very low.

12. Your Rights

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have rights including access to, correction of, or deletion of your personal data. As Debriefed does not collect personally identifiable data, we cannot identify you as an individual in our systems.

13. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. When we do, we will update the "Last Updated" date at the top of this document and, where appropriate, notify users through the App. Continued use of the App after changes are posted constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.

We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy periodically.
